National Park Service Announces 2025 Free Admission Days



- January 20: Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
- April 19: First day of National Park Week
- June 19: Juneteenth National Independence Day
- August 4: Anniversary of the Great American Outdoors Act
- September 27: National Public Lands Day
- November 11: Veterans Day



Valley Forge Stories: Elizabeth Thompson

General George Washington needed a housekeeper for many reasons, and one of the more important reasons was frequently moving his residence for security purposes. After one housekeeper was promptly removed as she may



have been involved in an attempted plot to kill George Washington, he found Elizabeth Thompson, who had excellent work credentials.

Although she was illiterate, she quickly took full control of many of Washington's domestic household staff. She interacted well with Martha Washington whenever she was present at any of the camps or homes with Washington. Thompson would be trusted to maintain any necessary secrecy in connection with any new location or travel plans. The fact that she remained in this position for five years is a testament to the trust placed in her by General Washington. There are

no known paintings of her.

Kennedy Supplee Mansion Leasing Opportunity

We have some exciting news! The Kennedy Supplee Mansion is available for a ten-year lease beginning as early as January 2029 following a comprehensive rehabilitation by the National Park Service. Allowable uses include restaurant, other light commercial use, or office. A Request for Proposals is scheduled to be released in January 2025. Check out the full story here.



A Brief History of the Mansion

Constructed in 1852, the Kennedy Supplee Mansion is a Victorian mansion in the Italianate-Italian style villa featuring Egyptian Revival interior decorations. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

In 1986, Kennedy Supplee Associates LP (KSA) signed a 55-year lease with the National Park Service, restored the building, and operated it as the Kennedy Supplee Mansion Restaurant. Following the 1987 renovation by KSA, the restaurant operated with approximately 1,100 square feet of dining space located on the first and approximately 2,200 square feet of dining and bar space on the second floor. The company entered Chapter 11 bankruptcy in 2005 and the mansion has been vacant since 2006.
